

TIGER BAND CARDINALS FUNDRAISING

We are in our sixth year of fundraising at Busch Stadium. The nuts and bolts of how this works are below:

REQUIREMENTS:

1. You must attend one training session at Busch Stadium prior to working concessions.
2. You must be at least 21 to work concessions due to the alcohol sales.

GAME DAY:

1. Dress in appropriate attire - black shorts/pants, black shoes, white t-shirt, OHS visor.
2. We car pool from OHS to the stadium to avoid paying multiple parking fees.
3. Report to the stadium three hours before game time to check in and prep our stand.
4. Once the gates open, we are open for business. Our stand will be staffed with a stand manager, grill cook and fry cook. We are responsible for manning the cash registers, restocking food items on the front counter and wrapping hot dogs, hamburgers, etc.
5. The games usually last about three hours. Once the stand manager gives the okay, we can close down the stand and turn in all monies.
6. From start to finish, this is about a 7 hour day.

MONEY MATTERS:

As a group, we earn a percentage of the net sales of the stand. You will earn one share of the net sales percentage for each game you work. We do this on a game by game basis to be fair - obviously, your stand will earn more money for a Cards/Cubs series on a Saturday night than it will for a Cards/Reds series on a Sunday afternoon.

Funds will be deposited directly into your student's band account as soon as we receive the final money sheets and check from Busch Stadium, usually about four weeks after a game. These funds can be used for band fees or trip payments.

ODDS AND ENDS:

1. Yes, multiple people may work for one student's benefit. If you and your spouse work, your student's account will be credited with two shares for that game.
2. Yes, we have to be at the stadium three hours before the game. You wouldn't believe how many nachos trays we need to fill before the game! Of course, there are times where things come up, and if you need to arrive later, just let Julie know and we'll see if we can make arrangements with the stadium.
3. Carpooling is the best option as parking is expensive at the stadium. We purchase parking tickets from our tip money at a discounted rate to cover the parking costs of the carpool drivers.
